### General Information for Undergraduate Applicants

At Ashesi University, we realize that a student's academic performance and ability to contribute in classes and group projects are important. Therefore, we review each application closely, considering the following criteria:

#### Academic Records

- Senior Secondary School transcripts
- English translation of transcripts and course descriptions where necessary

#### Standard Examination Results

One or more of the following examination results is required:

- West African Senior Secondary School Examination (WASSCE) **and/or** Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (SSSCE) scores – a minimum score of Aggregate 24 is required to apply. **Please note that to be competitive, a score of 15 or better is typically needed.**
- IGCSE/GCE 'O' Level / 'A' Level or equivalent scores
- International Baccalaureate scores accompanied by IGCSE scores
- French Baccalaureate (a certified copy of the original score and a certified translated copy in English)
- SAT scores

#### Extracurricular Activities

- It is important to let us know what your interests are outside the classroom (e.g. chess, community service, football, etc.)

#### Essays

- Minimum of one essay is required (see application form)

#### Interview

- By invitation only

## Information for International Students

The application procedure and timetable are the same for both international candidates and candidates applying from schools in Ghana. If a secondary school transcript or any other supporting document is in a language other than English, submit certified copies of an exact translation of the document in addition to the certified copies of the original document(s).

International students for whom English is a second language must submit their results for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) Exam. The minimum passing grade required by Ashesi University is **550** for the paper-based exam or **213** for the computer-based exam.

**Please note that international students who gain admission will pay a one-time registration fee of \$200.00**

## Information for Transfer Students

Transfer candidates must provide official transcripts from each college or university attended. It is your responsibility to ensure that an official transcript has been received from each institution attended in order to complete your application.

Ashesi does not accept transfers into the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year of our program. A transfer student who is admitted to Ashesi University will be placed in the 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> year and will be eligible to take classes from the 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year, depending on the number of credits they are able to transfer into Ashesi's curriculum from their previous university. Only courses with a grade of C+ equivalent or better that fit with Ashesi's curriculum will be transferred from a previous university.

## Submitting Your Application

You may drop your completed application off at Ashesi University or mail it to the address listed below. It is your responsibility to ensure that your application reaches Ashesi University by the application deadline. Please note that Ashesi will **NOT** accept completed applications that are faxed to the admissions office.
